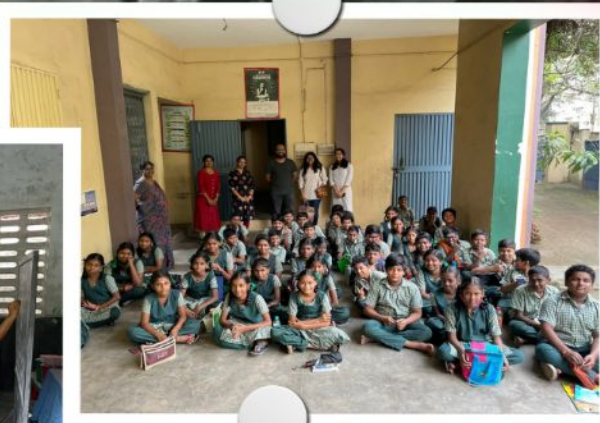

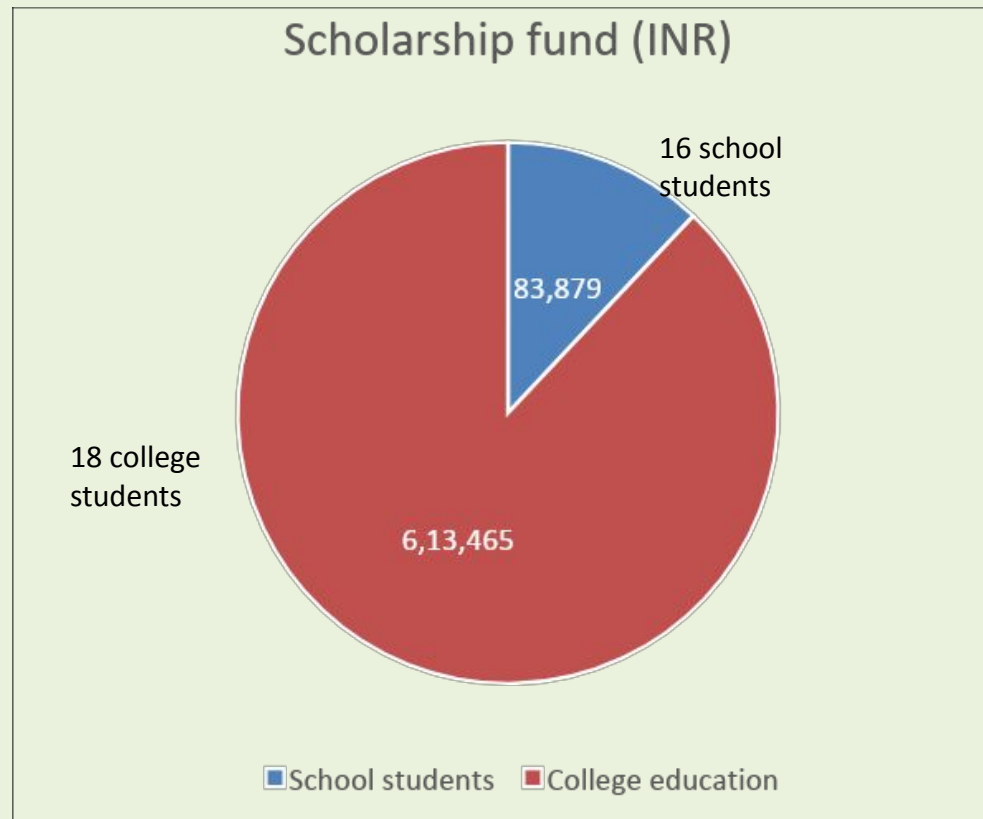

Criteria for scholarship decisions



Criteria for deciding Scholarships:

- Need-based.
- Students studying in College but finding it difficult to pay college / exam fee are given priority.
- Payment direct to college is preferred where feasible.
- School students, referred by volunteers or school Principal are also considered for scholarship as a motivating gesture.
- All applications are processed as per guidelines of Deepam Scholarship Committee.
